
#### PE

For this term your child's PE provision will be outdoor sports. They will need to have full P.E kit in school every Tuesday. We encourage children to leave their PE kit in school all half term.

Children will participate in an English and Maths session each morning, with Science, ICT and the foundation subjects taught in the afternoon. The afternoon sessions will be linked by a topic. Each child is also in a phonics group and has one phonics lesson a day.

#### English

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#### Topic

This term, the main focus for children will be the development of their skills in number and calculation.




In Year 1 we are learning about numbers, fractions and money. We need to be able to count to 100 and read 2 digit numbers. We will also learn how to add single digit and 2 digit numbers.

#### Science
